Start and finish time reminder - The School day starts at 8.50 a.m. and finishes at 3.15 p.m. On arrival pupils should go straight onto the playground. There is a teacher on duty in the playground from 8.35 a.m. and another adult on gate duty.

Parents should note that it is not possible for children to arrive before this time as the Academy cannot accept responsibility for their safety and well-being. On arrival, they should go straight to the playground.

The children are supervised on leaving school at 3.15 p.m. If you are intending to collect your child please be punctual and notify the School should you be late.

If you need your child to be in school prior to 8.35 a.m. our Breakfast Club facility is available from 8.10 a.m. for a cost of £2 per day.

School Meals - Cost of a school meal is now £2.03. Dinner money needs to be paid on the day or in advance, either in cash or via ParentPay. (Meals will not be provided if no payment is received.) If you do not have login details for ParentPay and would like to start using this method, please contact the school office.

Infectious Diseases - We currently have a pupil who may be more susceptible to infectious disease. If your child contracts chicken pox, measles or any other childhood disease could you please inform the school as soon as possible.

Going up to Secondary School? - If your child is in Year 6 you must apply by 31st October, 2015. Apply online eastsussex.gov.uk/schools

Uniform - Please can we request that tights are plain white/navy or black as we come to the colder weather. Shoes should be sensible black shoes or plain black trainers.

Missing Uniform - Please check the labels to ensure children have picked up their own sweatshirts, coats etc. as clothing can sometimes get muddled after P.E. and playtimes.

Choir - Mrs. Kempton will be running choir 3.15-4.15 Thursdays. Please collect, sign and return permission slips at the office.

Parent Forum - The first Parent Forum meeting will be held on Thursday 5th November at 2.30 p.m. Please let us know if you can attend.
