Aims and Objectives

School uniform plays a valuable role in contributing to the ethos of our school and setting an appropriate tone. A uniform supports positive behaviour and discipline; ensures pupils of all races and backgrounds feel welcome; protects children from social pressures to dress in a particular way; nurtures cohesion and promotes good relations between different groups of pupils. Governors and parents support the wearing of uniform and recognise the contribution this makes towards the school ethos.



At All Saints, we want a uniform which:

- promotes a sense of pride in the school
- establishes a sense of community and belonging towards the school
- is practical and smart
- promotes equality (please see Equalities Statement)
- is comfortable and regarded as suitable wear for school
- is affordable and designed with health and safety in mind

Our School Uniform

School uniform is required for all pupils. Our uniform colours are dark blue and pale yellow. Superstitch 86 have sweaters, fleeces, polo t-shirts and accessories such as caps and reading book bags with the academy's logo. Pupils do not need to wear branded uniform so long as colours are adhered to. Branded uniform can be ordered through the Superstitch 86 website: <https://www.superstitch86.co.uk/> Non-branded uniform is widely available from supermarkets and clothes retailers.

Uniform details

- Pale yellow polo shirt
- Dark blue sweatshirt, fleece or cardigan
- Plain navy or black skirt, pinafore dress, trousers or shorts
- Gingham dress in yellow or blue
- Plain navy or black socks or tights
- Plain black shoes, leather or leather look, with flat or low heel or all black trainers



PE Kit

Children come to school in their PE kit should a PE lesson fall on that day. Branded white t-shirts with the academy's logo are available from Superstitch 86 but pupils do not need to wear branded uniform. Should a child not have PE kit in school, spare kit is available.

- Plain black or navy shorts or joggers
- White T-shirt
- Plimsolls or trainers

Other uniform requirements

- Pupils are not permitted to wear makeup, nail varnish or acrylic/false nails.
- Long hair must be tied back. We will provide hair bands for pupils if hair is not tied.
- No jewellery except stud earrings are allowed. This includes bracelets, necklaces and rings.
- Leggings, joggers and jeans are not permitted.
- Boots, sliders and open-toe shoes are not allowed.
- Due to cloakroom space limitations, pupils **should not** bring a rucksack or backpack to school.
- Parents and pupils should decide which uniform is suitable for weather / time of year.
